

  The site has been lost or is beyond a cost-feasible restoration effort.
  The site is in a severely degraded condition and will require considerable restoration.
  The site is in a somewhat degraded condition and will require some restoration.
  The site is in a acceptable condition, but its condition could be improved.
  The site is in good condition and will require little work.
  The site is in excellent condition, requires no work and is an example of a well-preserved site of that type.
