BIRD FEEDER FUN

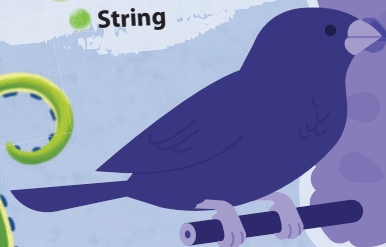
Transform a **water bottle** into a **bird feeder** in six easy steps!

⚠️ Ask an adult to help when you see this sign!

What you'll need:

- Small clean plastic bottle
- Small sharp scissors
- Pencil or stick
- Drawing pin
- Bird seed
- String



Some octopuses make use of old coconut shells by hiding in them! Be **resourceful** like an octopus by giving your water bottle a **second life**!

1

Use the drawing pin to make two holes on opposite sides of the bottle near the bottom. Then widen the holes slightly with the scissors.



2

Push a pencil through the holes to make a perch.



3

Use the drawing pin and scissors to make six drainage holes in the bottom of the bottle.



Don't make the holes too big or the bird seed will spill out!

4

Using the scissors, cut out small feeding holes about 5cm above each perch.

Make two more holes on opposite sides near the top of the bottle and thread some string through.

Fill with bird seed, put the cap back on and hang your fantastic feeder up outside!

Here's what happens when we don't recycle!



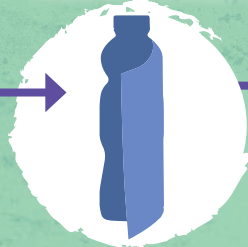
